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The Los Angeles Unified School District's Facilities Services Division provides services in the area of new construction, maintenance of existing facilities and grounds, real estate management, and school utilization. The Division provides facilities support for over 1100 school campuses and office sites in a 710 square mile geographic area.

The spotlight has shifted from the \$19.5 billion New Construction Program, which was the largest school construction program in the nation's history, to the Modernization Program. To date, 105 new schools have been completed, along with 113 addition/expansion projects and the completion of over 20,000 modernization and repair projects. Over \$4 billion in construction and modernization projects have yet to be completed including the completion of 30 new school projects. The Chief Facilities Executive and Deputy Chief Facilities Executive will be dedicated to the goals of providing relief from overcrowding and returning students to a traditional two-semester calendar, as well as ensuring that existing campuses are modernized and repaired in support of the education and safety of students.

THE IDEAL CANDIDATE

The ideal candidates for the positions will possess considerable facilities construction and management experience at the executive level. Experience will include oversight of multiple, complex, multi-year construction and facility modernization projects with values exceeding \$200 million. The Chief Facilities Executive and Deputy Chief Facilities Executive will be effective yet compassionate leaders who make positive decisions for the Division and for the District as a whole. The executives will have significant managerial experience in promoting a results-oriented facilities team while functioning within the legal and fiscal parameters of public bond funds. These executives will also be exceptional communicators with excellent negotiating and networking skills combined with an aggressive approach to facilities operations and construction; will have successful experience working with elected officials; and will be team players who will encourage staff to work together with the entire District to reach critical goals.
