1. What is the difference between Category 5, 5E and 6?
2. When does it become cost effective to cable using Category 6 cable?
3. Are many corporate buildings using wireless technology for networking?
4. What is required for new cabling as far as cable installation, city electrical permitting, systemic loading requirements, existing cable removal and preexisting non conforming electrical permitting issues?
5. What termination products are available to us when installing cubicles or wall plate locations?
6. Is there a vendor available that will remove our existing cable at no charge for the salvage value of the cable?
7. What are the maximum lengths that we can run cabling before experiencing data transmission loss.
8. What are the things that we should not do when having cable installed such as laying cable across florescent light fixtures?
9. When do you use fiber optic systems?
10. What do the different grades of fiber optic cable mean?
