## "Your Building **Fire Life** **Safety System** and

### what you should know"

The August IFMA OC Roundtable Discussion will take place on the 24<sup>th</sup> at 11:30am. This month's topic will be a discussion of Fire Life Safety Systems within our buildings and what should be done to keep them up to code and in compliance with our employee and government jurisdictions. We will be targeting the building fire alarm systems that trigger a building evacuation and also the support available to maintain these systems. We will also be sharing with other attendees our type of building systems and who maintains them. As well as what are the latest NFPA requirements for building fire alarm systems. Our intent for this meeting is to have a fire department representative on site for this meeting as well as a Fire Life Safety contractor to inform us to the current requirements.

Some of the questions to be discussed will include:

1. How often is a building evacuation drill required?
2. How do I know if my building meets current NFPA Fire Life Safety requirements?
3. Do I need to test my evacuation alarm system at any required interval?
4. Do I need to change out my flashing strobes if they are not synchronized?
5. Can I perform in-house testing of my FLS system and still meet NFPA and city fire department requirements?
6. Can we have a list of those who are licensed to work on FLS systems?
7. Do we need to have an off-site monitoring company for our alarm system?
8. What are the experiences of other Facilities Managers who invite the fire department in for fire drills?
9. When are public address systems required for building Fire Life Safety Systems?
