## SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION 2010 - 2011

In today's job market, corporate climate and rapidly changing technology demand that facility managers keep up with all the changes in the world as well as within their own organization. Our chapter needs to help its members grow and help those who choose to continue expanding their horizons as the corporate world demands. The Orange County Chapter of IFMA will be providing several educational scholarships to help its members achieve this goal.

### **OC IFMA Educational Scholarship Purpose**

The purpose of the Educational Scholarship shall be to provide funding for educational opportunities that promote the advancement of professional facility managers.

- Scholarships will be available for each of the CFM/FMP courses.
- Scholarships will be available for the CFM Study review course.
- Two scholarships per quarter will be available for courses taken at UCI related to facility professional education, (UCI scholarships will be limited to \$300.00 each).

### **Selection Criteria**

The Selection Board shall consist of the Executive Board.

- Application deadline for the CFM study review scholarships will be 30 days prior to the class date.
- Application deadline for the CFM/FMP courses will be 30 days prior to the class date.

Application deadline for UCI education course will be 30 days prior to quarter registration dates during Winter and Spring sessions.

### **Submission Requirements**

Applicant must be a professional member in good standing, and maintain the membership for the duration of the educational period. In addition, applicant must not be receiving reimbursement or scholarship compensation from employer or other commercial source. The scholarship is intended to assist those who would normally be required to pay individually. A sworn statement confirming the employer will not fund the educational expenses needs to accompany the application.

Submit a written application addressing the following criteria,

1. Your Name
2. Your Current Employer (or state "In Transition" if between assignments)
3. Professional resume, with educational history
4. Current and future career goals
5. History of IFMA involvement and participation
6. A brief statement addressing why you should receive a scholarship over and above other applicants
